The School Improvement Plan

Key questions to consider when writing a SIP are:

- Which things must we do because they are necessary to raise standards and because they will have the biggest impact on outcomes for pupils?
- How are we going to do them?
- Which issues do we have in common with other providers in the locality and, therefore, what actions might be better undertaken collaboratively by, or within, partnerships?

The plan should:

- Have a small number of headline priorities, a clear rationale and success criteria
- Include a one-page summary backed by more detailed action plans available to those who need them
- Be written in clear, simple English
